

CLAIMS CERTIFICATE, Volvo Cars & partners

Deductibles – damage on corporate cars

This claims certificate is only required if the company is to pay the entire excess.

A prerequisite is that a damage report has been made to the insurance company in order to proceed.

This form should be filled in and signed and taken to an authorised Volvo dealer if it is established that the company will pay the excess or a cost that is below the excess. If the certificate is missing, the car owner will pay part of the excess, equivalent to 10% of a price base amount, when the car is collected after the repair is completed.
